THEATRE ARTS, ASSOCIATE OF ARTS (AA): DESIGN/ LIGHTING AND/OR COSTUMING/MAKEUP

Overview

The Theater Arts Department offers a variety of programs of study and experience suited to the needs of the serious theater student as well as those who wish to include theater as a part of their liberal arts education. With curricula in Acting/Directing, Design/Lighting, Costuming and Technical Production, the program provides an intensive two-year course of study that prepares Theater Arts majors for transfer to a fouryear college or university - ready to do advanced upper-division work.

Students have the opportunity of working in all phases of production and performance, and are encouraged to take on increasing levels of responsibility.

Requirements

Associate Degree Graduation Requirements

Complete all of the following:

- 1. All Department Requirements listed below with a "C" or better or "P" in each course (at least 20% of the department requirements must be completed through SBCC).
- 2. One of the following three General Education options:

- 3. A total of 60 degree-applicable units (SBCC courses numbered 100 and higher).
- 4. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in all units attempted at SBCC.
- 5. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in all college units attempted.
- 6. A minimum of 12 units through SBCC.
